Background

<u>The Lesma Ellis Foundation</u>, a Jamaican non-profit organisation, is dedicated to <u>empowering inner-city</u> and <u>rural youth</u> through <u>education</u>, <u>skills development</u>, <u>and transformative training programmes</u>. Operating in challenging environments characterised by <u>limited resources and socio-economic volatility</u>, the foundation strives to break cycles of disadvantage by equipping young people with the essential skills needed for future employment.

Since partnering with <u>Alison</u> in Q1 of 2025, the foundation has embraced <u>scalable digital learning</u> to extend its reach beyond the limitations of traditional in-person training. The move aligns perfectly with <u>Alison's vision of accessible</u>, <u>inclusive</u>, <u>and empowering education</u>, helping to <u>close skills gaps and foster employability for underserved communities</u>.

The **Challenges**

Despite its impactful mission and dedicated efforts, the **Lesma Ellis Foundation** encounters several obstacles that shape its operational landscape.

- Scalability: Traditional in-person workshops limited the number of youth who could be reached due to geographic barriers and resource constraints.
- Accessibility: Inner-city participants often encountered unstable environments, while rural communities suffered from limited educational infrastructure.
- ✓ Engagement: Ensured learners remained motivated and completed courses amidst external socio-economic pressures.
- ✓ Technology Adoption: Hurdles to incorporating a learning platform that could be quickly implemented, user-friendly, and aligned with learners' contexts and needs.







"Operating without a physical base in Jamaica presents ongoing hurdles; our dedicated volunteers must navigate logistical and infrastructure challenges daily, limiting how much we can grow and reach. The **Alison Solution**

The Lesma Ellis Foundation partnered with Alison to deliver accredited digital education and Certification opportunities, overcoming educational and infrastructural barriers in underserved Jamaican communities.

This partnership enables scalable, flexible access to vital skills training that empowers youth and adults alike.

- ✓ Rapid deployment: Alison's LMS+ was set up swiftly, enabling the seamless onboarding

 of over 179 learners within months.
- ✓ Curated curricula: Popular courses like "Toolkit for Cybersecurity Professionals," "CPR AED First Aid," and "Business Management Essentials" delivered relevant, employable skills.
- Flexible learning: The platform enabled learners to access courses anytime, anywhere, increasing inclusivity and completion rates.
- Comprehensive support: Ongoing Alison support ensured smooth functionality and encouraged learner engagement and certificate attainment.
- Data insights: Tracking active users (129) and certificate achievements (133 purchased) helped measure impact and refine programme delivery.

Quantifying **Success**

Since partnering with Alison's online learning platform, the LMS+, the Lesma Ellis Foundation has made significant strides in advancing digital literacy and educational empowerment within underserved Jamaican communities.

- Expanded Curriculum: Inclusion of in-demand courses addressing job market needs like cybersecurity and business management
- Seamless Setup: Quick LMS implementation and adoption with minimal technical hurdles
- **⊘** Growing Engagement: 179 learners enrolled across 129 active learners demonstrating sustained interest
- ✓ Measurable Outcomes: 133 certificates awarded, reflecting real learner achievement and motivation
- Scalability: Capacity to support increasing numbers without compromising learner experience
- ❷ Holistic Support: Back-end LMS support facilitating consistent course access and guidance

<u>Alison's LMS+</u> enables the foundation's team to prioritise <u>educational impact</u>, <u>focusing energies on mentoring and learner support</u> rather than technical platform management.
